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Duke Companies is one of the few builders in the region that focuses solely on multifamily construction. Its strong relationship with its local lenders, investors, landowners, and developers can be attributed to the company's accommodating business practices. For instance, the company carefully creates investment and building programs that suit the structural needs as well as the economic requirements of its clients.



The firm is a family-owned and privately-held business, founded in 1973. Even in its early years, it accomplished much for the multi-unit industry. Through the 1970s and the 1980s, it completed numerous apartment home communities. In 2001, it reached its milestone of completing 20,000 high-end multi-residential homes, sealing its reputation as one of the region's most experienced builders. In a span of five years, it reached another record and completed 5,000 more apartment homes. The firm is now under the leadership of Robert J. Stone III.

The Westover Hills and the Braun Station are the most notable works that the firm has completed in Dallas. The latter is a \$20-million three-story garden residence that houses 288 units. The former is a two-story multifamily project that cost over \$10 million in construction and holds 240 units. These projects showcase luxury amenities such as swimming pools, concrete pool decks, and open-air areas for parties and socializing.
